

Delaware Family Campground is a family oriented resort. Please review the following policies and share them with your family members and guests. Our goal is to provide a clean, safe and enjoyable atmosphere for all campers.

In Consideration of others

- Quiet hours: from 11pm to 8am - NJ Law
- All campfires out by 12:30am
- No loud music, excessive noise or disorderly conduct
- Children ages 17 and under are to be supervised by an adult/guardian at all times

For your safety

- Please supervise children at all times around water areas
- Do not leave campfires unattended
- Do not move fire rings or tables
- Only bathing suits may be worn in the pool
- Life jackets must be worn at all times while on the river
- No smoking or glass containers are permitted inside pool area
- Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult at all times while at the pool
- Children under 17 years old must wear a helmet when riding their bicycles, scooters, skateboards or roller blades - NJ Law - and no riding after dark
- Fireworks, firecrackers, explosives or weapons of any kind are not permitted
- Please keep your campsite clean as well as the recreation areas
- No cutting trees, branches or vegetation

General Information

Office & Camp Store: Open from 8am to 10pm Friday & Saturday, 8am to 9pm Sunday through Thursday. In the Spring and Fall, we close early. Security gate closes when the office closes.

Guests: Campers are responsible for registration, payment and behavior of their guests. Guests must register and receive a pass before entering the resort. Guests must check-out by 10pm. Management reserves the right to limit the number of guests.

Pets: Pets are welcome family members for those joining us with their own trailer or tent. For the courtesy of others who may have allergies, we do not allow pets in our rental units, unless you request a designated pet-friendly cabin rental. If your pet is joining you for your stay, please observe the following:

- Clean up after your pet
- Do not leave your pet unattended
- Keep on a non-extendable leash, no more than 6 feet and under control at all times
- Maintain a license and all required shots with documentation available upon immediate request
- Anyone disobeying pet policy rules will not be allowed to walk their pets
- Camper agrees to reimburse and/or indemnify the campground for any personal injury or property damage caused by the actions of his/her animal.

River/Fishing: Fishing license required. No swimming in the river.

River Rentals: Available at office. Each person must wear a life jacket at all times. River rentals must be in by 6 pm or when bad weather occurs.

Swimming Facilities: Open from Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day. No lifeguard on duty. Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult. No swimming alone. Available for use only during hours posted.

Firewood: For your convenience, firewood is available in the camp store. Due to environmental consideration, firewood may not be brought into the resort.

Bicycles/Scooters/Skateboards: All children under 17 years old must wear safety helmets - NJ law. Hoverboards and electric or gas scooters are not permitted.

Motorbikes: Motorbikes or non-registered motorcycles are not permitted. No mini bikes, ATVs, go-carts or motorized scooters may be ridden or stored on resort.

Vehicles: No more than one car per campsite. Additional cars must be parked in parking lot. Only licensed drivers may operate a vehicle on resort property. All NJ motor vehicle laws apply.

Electric hook-ups: To be used for lights only. Patio lights out at 11pm. No spot lights. No electric hot water heaters.

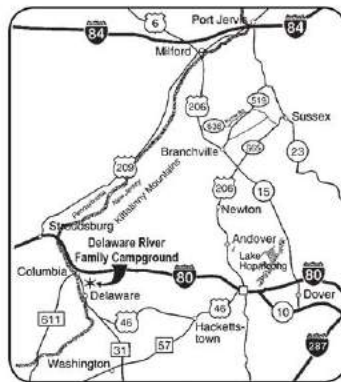
Alcohol: Alcoholic beverages are restricted for those 21 years and older.

Gate Tokens: Gate closes when offices closes. Tokens are available at the office for a fee to open gate after hours.

DIRECTIONS TO DELAWARE RIVER FAMILY CAMPGROUND:

From the George Washington Bridge: Rt. 80 West, Exit 48 to Rt. 46 East, 3 miles on the right.

From Pennsylvania:

Stroudsburg area - Rt. 80 East to New Jersey, Exit 48 to Rt. 46 East, 3 miles on the right.

Milford area - Rt. 209 to Milford Bridge to Rt. 206 South in New Jersey to Newton to Rt. 94 South to Rt. 46 East, 3 miles on right.

From New York State: New York Thruway (Rt. 87), Exit 15 to New Jersey Rt. 287 South to Rt. 80 West, Exit 48 to Rt. 46 East, 3 miles on right.

From Central or South Jersey: Take the Garden State Parkway North or NJ Turnpike North to Route 287 North. Follow Route 287 North to Route 78 West. Take Route 78 West to Route 31 North to Route 46 West. Follow Route 46 West for approximately 6 miles, and the campground entrance will be on left.

OR

Take the Garden State Parkway North or NJ Turnpike North to Route 287 North. Follow Route 287 North to Route 206 North. Take Route 206 North to Route 80 West. Continue on Rt. 80 West to exit 48, Route 46 East. Follow Route 46 East for 3 miles. The campground entrance will be on right.

This campground property is privately owned.
